Air Force Qualification Training Package (AFQTP) Remote Area Lighting System (RALS)

SYNOPSIS:

HQ AFCESA/CEOF, in association with Applied Research Associates, Inc., recently completed a new AFQTP CD-ROM – **Remote Area Lighting Systems**. This computer-based software program was distributed to all Civil Engineer Unit Education & Training Managers to meet upgrade training requirements in support of the Civil Engineer AFQTP program.

CONTENTS:

This program presents standardized, step-by-step guidance for specific tasks identified in the Career Field Education and Training Plan. All three RALS core tasks found in the Electrical Systems Specific Contingency Responsibilities module are discussed here.

The program consists of four individual lessons that must be taken in order. Areas of discussion include RALS operating principles, individual components, setup requirements, system operational procedures, tear down and storage requirements, and a description of pre- and post-operational inspection and maintenance requirements.

This product, along with the paper-based version of the RALS training segment located within the Electrical Systems' Module 27, *AFSC Specific Contingency Responsibilities*, is mandatory for upgrade training. Besides providing new technicians with valuable information, it can also be used as a refresher tool for experienced technicians and supervisors. Review questions are included at the end of each segment or lesson.
