SYNOPSIS:

This brand new video is designed to provide all Air Force active duty, Reserve, Air National Guard, and civilian personnel assigned to base civil engineer Prime BEEF teams with a comprehensive basic understanding of the Prime BEEF program. This training asset covers the Prime BEEF mission; Prime BEEF forces and team structure; Prime BEEF training and equipment; Prime BEEF deployment and the individual's responsibilities for deployment; and finally, recall procedures.

BACKGROUND:

As the world's only remaining super power, the United States is committed to supporting worldwide peacekeeping missions during regional conflicts between developing or politically unstable nations. Additionally, the United States' commitment to provide humanitarian relief, support drug interdiction operations, and uphold American interests has significantly increased the frequency with which we deploy and sustain military forces, often at multiple locations simultaneously.

To meet the challenges of global readiness, the Air Force has developed the Air and Space Expeditionary Force concept to deploy its forces. The Prime BEEF program is based on Civil Engineer doctrine and is a key component of AEF deployments. It is essential that all civil engineer personnel become well grounded in Prime BEEF concepts and procedures.
