SUBJECT: Revised Utilities Privatization (UP) Program Guidance

As a result of the recent release of the Revised Utilities Privatization Program Guidance (Atch 1) by DepSecDef, several changes are being made to the Air Force Utilities Privatization (UP) program. I request your support and the support of your staff in executing this program in a timely manner.

The primary change is the adjustment of the completion milestone from 30 Sep 03 to 30 Sep 05. We are in the process of developing a new, aggressive completion schedule for the remaining utility systems. Recently AFCESA sent your MAJCOM CEs a letter requesting they prioritize the remaining systems to enable us to build this schedule. Close coordination with your staff is vital to the successful completion of this program.

In addition, for systems determined to have no market interest or to be uneconomical, the guidance directs that the local utility provider must be approached to determine their interest in the system. This final step ensures every opportunity to privatize a utility system has been explored before attempting to exempt it for economic reasons.
