Notes:

- Upgrade Training requirements for USAF military fire fighters includes professional military education (PME) that is not included in this chart
- For purposes of attending training, required (priority) training is the training required for the current as well as the next higher level duty position. (Example: Required training for a Crew Chief is that training required for a Crew Chief and Station Chief)
- For purposes of attending training, desired training is that training above the current and next highest duty position, normally not considered in the best interest of the DoD. It is not considered appropriate use of government resources for individuals to pursue training that is not required or too far in advance of need
- WMD is a recent addition to the HAZMAT job performance requirements (NFPA 472). Pending the inclusion of WMD in DoD HAZMAT training systems, the *Emergency Response to Terrorism - For Emergency Responders* course should be completed separately. This course has been provided to each DoD Fire Department
- This chart depicts the minimum certification requirements to occupy positions indicated. Local managers determine additional training and certifications for service- or installation-specific missions (such as CPR, HAZMAT Tech and EMT)
