NEW COMPUTER-BASED GENERAL CONTINGENCY COURSE

SYNOPSIS:

This supersedes A-Gram 00-08, dated February 2000. We are happy to announce the availability of a computer-based course of instruction covering general contingency topics. This program replaces the paper-based Career Development Course (CDC) 3E050, which was withdrawn from production last year.

In addition to numerous revisions, this new digitized version makes extensive use of narration, supporting video clips and color drawings/photographic enhancements. As indicated below, this electronic product includes all of the general contingency topics previously included in CDC 3E050 with appropriate updates.

LESSON TOPICS:

2. First Aid
3. Field Sanitation, Personal Hygiene, and Pestborne Disease
4. Self-Protection from Extreme Weather
5. Personal and Work Party Security

As was the case with the paper-based CDC, satisfactory completion of this course meets Category I Home Station training requirements outlined in AFI 10-210, Chapter 3.
