COMPUTER-BASED READINESS TRAINING COURSE CD-ROM— EXERCISE EVALUATION TEAM (EET)

SYNOPSIS:

We have recently completed a new computer-based Readiness training course CD-ROM – Exercise Evaluation Team (EET). This CD-ROM presents the Installation EET course and is intended for civil engineer Readiness specialists that teach the EET course. Installation Exercise Evaluation team chiefs may also use this program to train newly assigned EET members.

COURSE CONTENTS:

This program covers the Installation Full Spectrum Threat Response (FSTR) and Exercise Evaluation program. It is designed to help the instructor put together and deliver effective,

standardized training for newly assigned EET members. The program contains four major parts, which are similar to a standard course of instruction.

An introduction and an optional course completion certificate are included. The introduction provides an overview of the program and explains how the instructor uses the computer-based course.

Part one discusses the lesson plan and course content. The EET Course presentation is contained in part two. This is the instructor-led classroom presentation.

Student evaluation methods are contained in part three. A test bank of multiple-

choice questions is available for download by the instructor. Part four contains auxiliary course-related material. This material includes the instructor's lesson plan, a student guide, and a sample EET Handbook. All of these documents may be downloaded and modified by the instructor. This allows the instructor to add local procedures or policies.

An optional Course Completion Certificate is included at the end of the program. This CD-ROM course utilizes narration, video clips and over 250 photographs and illustrations that hold student interest and provide standardized classroom training.
