# Computer-based Prime BEEF Home Station Training, Volume 3

### SYNOPSIS:

HQ AFCE/CEXX recently completed another new computer-based Prime BEEF home station training product. This CD-ROM presents material supporting Prime BEEF Category I home station training program outlined in attachment 2 to AFI 10-210, *Prime Base Engineer Emergency Force (BEEF) Program*. This Prime BEEF training product is the third volume in a series of five home station volumes scheduled for release.

### COURSE CONTENT:

This CD-ROM contains four separate courses on a variety of subjects. These courses should provide sufficient information and guidance to educate Prime BEEF troops regarding their responsibilities.

The first course, *Repair Quality Criteria*, walks through the procedures for determining how smooth the craters at a specific location must be to satisfy strict airfield damage repair criteria. These detailed procedures ensure quality repairs, so that aircraft are not harmed during launch and recovery operations.

Course number two, *European Utility Systems*, covers a number of European systems, such as electrical, water, plumbing, sewage, and POL. If troops are not familiar with the differences between US and European systems, this is an excellent place to start.

*Field Sanitation and Personal Hygiene*, course three, goes into great detail to educate personnel about factors that can cause serious illness at home station or on deployments. Keeping everyone healthy is no easy task, and this information will help make supervisors' jobs a little easier.

Finally, course four on *Expedient Road and Drainage Techniques* is very relevant in light of recent deployments to Bosnia and Southwest and South Central Asia. Sometimes standard road and drainage building practices don't suffice, and special techniques must be employed. While many of the techniques discussed would be considered quite primitive, sometimes they are the techniques that work the best.
