Three Level General Contingency Responsibilities Course

SYNOPSIS:

The Three Level General Contingency Responsibilities (3 Level GCR) Program is designed to educate new airmen on crucial Category I contingency training tasks. Completion of this program will result in initial CAT I training credit for those areas indicated in attachment 2 to AFI 10-210, *Prime Base Engineer Emergency Force (BEEF) Program*. Reference the "GCRCD" annotation in the "optional source for training material" column of the attachment.

This course replaces the General Contingency block of instruction students initially received at the 366th Training Squadron. The training has been removed to allow more time for vital hands-on, AFS-specific training.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

It is the responsibility of every airman to ensure this course is completed within **90 days** after arrival at his/her first duty station. Airmen may also complete the course while in casual status while awaiting their technical training course.

COURSE MANAGEMENT:

The information contained in the course edifies Prime BEEF wartime contingency tasks. Therefore, it is imperative that the Readiness Flights properly manage this course and its students.

COURSEWEAR SPECIFICS:

The 3 Level GCR course is a two-disc set consisting of 17 lessons of instruction, complete with installation directions for local area network and stand-alone administration.
