Colonel Gus G. Elliott, Jr. is the Commander, Headquarters Air Force Civil Engineer Support Agency, Tyndall Air Force Base, Fla. AFCESA is an Air Force Field Operating Agency responsible for providing the best tools, practices and professional support to maximize Air Force civil engineer capabilities in base and contingency operations. The agency currently supports 82 major and 10 minor active-duty installations, plus the 83 Air Force Reserve and Air National Guard installations.

Col. Elliott was commissioned in 1974 after graduating from the Virginia Military Institute with a degree in civil engineering. He was granted an educational delay and entered the Air Force in 1976 after earning a Master's Degree in civil and environmental engineering. He has spent 18 years at base level assignments and has commanded a support group as well as four civil engineer squadrons. Prior to this assignment, he was the Chief of the Mission Support Inspection Division, Inspector General, HQ Pacific Air Forces, Hickam AFB, Hawaii.
